ABOUT THE SEMINAR

India has one of the largest systems of education in the world offering facilities of education and training in almost all aspects of human creativity and intellectual endeavour. A major development since the last Education Policy 1986 has been the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 which laid down legal underpinnings for achieving universal elementary education. The present National Education Policy of India 2020 (NEP 2020) aims both at school and higher education institutions outlining vision of new education system in India that envisages 10+2 structure in school education will be modified with a new pedagogical and curricular restructuring of 5+3+3+4 covering ages 3-18 years.

For higher education it proposes a four year Multi-Disciplinary Bachelor Degree with multiple entry & exit options. The policy emphasizes the importance of high-quality teacher education. It aims to initiate several systemic reforms to encourage bright and talented young minds to take up the teaching profession.

In this context, this seminar is an attempt to share and discuss the applicability and implementation of NEP 2020 effectively in the teacher educational institutions across India. - Author should provide a declaration that the paper is original and not published anywhere else and not under review with any other publication.
- It is authors responsibility to ensure that all references and citations are correct and that the contribution does not contain any material that infringes copyright or is defamatory, obscene or otherwise unlawful or litigious. The paper should not have the similarity index more than 15%.
