





THE COLLEGE LIBRARY

The college has an excellent Library housed in a commodious hall. The library is equipped with a large number of books on Education in particular and on general subjects too. MEMBERSHIP AND BORROWING PRIVILEGES

All the students of B.Ed., M.Ed. and college staff members are the members of college library. B.Ed. students can get 3 books and M.Ed. can get 4 books issued from library for a tenure of 14 days with renewal facility. The students are privileged to get books issued for the final examination. There is a provision of 'Book Bank' for poor and needy students who are provided books for the whole year without having to get them reissued again.

Students have to return issued books in the library after 14 days; these can be reissued if required.

CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION:

- (a) The admission to B.Ed. Course in the colleges affiliated to Panjab University, Chandigarh, Punjabi University, Patiala and Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar for the session 2019-20 shall be made on the basis of the relative merit of the candidates in the Common Entrance Test, subject to the availability of seats in a particular subject combination and as per reservation policy of Government of Punjab.
- (b) The candidates are required to fill the choices of colleges and Major Subjects on the prescribed proforma on the B.Ed. admission website. He/she will be admitted to the college on the basis of merit for his/her category in the respective subject, provided he/she fulfils the requisite eligibility conditions.
- **Note:** No one who is already in employment (whole time or part time whether in honorary capacity or paid) shall be admitted to B.Ed. Course in a College of Education without taking leave from the employer/Institution/office etc. from the date of commencement of the academic session till the completion of practical skill in teaching examination.
- (c) Admission to the seats under 15% (All India) quota will be done as per Reservation Policy of the Central Govt.
- (d) When two or more candidates have secured equal marks in the Common Entrance Test their inter-se merit for admission will be decided on the following criteria:
 - i. Candidate with higher percentage of marks in qualifying degree.
 - ii. Candidate older in age shall rank higher in the order of merit.

FEE-STRUCTURE AND MODE OF PAYMENT OF COLLEGE DUES:

The payment of dues is as per the guidelines and amount determined by Panjab University, Chandigarh. The College also provides Post Matric Scholarship to SC / ST / OBC students under Post Matric Scheme by Punjab Govt. Social Welfare Department. - 1. Fee once paid is not refundable as per University norms..
- 2. The candidate who fails to deposit the fees and thus misses his/her chance for admission will have no further claim for admission.
- 3. Students from other Universities will have to produce their Migration Certificates within 30 days of their admission to the college.
- 4. Students admitted under SC/ST category will have to produce their original SC/ST certificate at the time of admission or else their admission will stand cancelled.

GENERAL CODE OF CONDUCT AND ATTENDANCE

- The students are required to maintain discipline of the highest order and any student violating rules and norms of the college will be dealt with strictly.
